### Applicants must satisfy these criteria (per sector):

- A TRB number must be provided in the application to indicate that teacher registration has been granted by the [Teachers Registration Board of Tasmania](#).
- A certified copy of the applicant's completed teaching qualifications must be submitted to the department to determine correct salary placement.

- To gain employment in a Catholic schools in Tasmania, teacher applicants must be or able to be registered with the [Teachers Registration Board of Tasmania](#).
- Successful applicants for CET and school- based positions are subject to screening prior to commencement of employment. This requires the individual to undergo a police check ([see form](#)) and mandatory reporting training.
