

The Teachers Registration Board of Tasmania does not employ teachers. All registered teachers must hold current <u>Registration to Work with Vulnerable People</u> with the Consumer Building and Occupational Services division of the Department of Justice Tasmania.

Department for Education, Children and Young People

All vacancies for positions of 12 months or more are advertised in the 'education' section of the Tasmanian government careers website. Visit <u>www.jobs.tas.gov.au</u>.

Temporary teaching vacancies of over 20 working days duration are known as fixed term teaching vacancies. These vacancies are filled via an <u>online employment</u> register.

Teachers wishing to be considered must be on the <u>employment register(s)</u> to be eligible for appointment.

Catholic Education Tasmania (CET), school leadership, teaching, and support staff vacancies are advertised in local Tasmanian newspapers and on <u>www.teachers.on.net</u>.

- Applicants must satisfy these criteria (per sector):
- A TRB number must be provided in the application to indicate that teacher registration has been granted by the <u>Teachers</u> <u>Registration Board of Tasmania</u>.
- A certified copy of the applicant's completed teaching qualifications must be submitted to the department to determine correct salary placement.

- To gain employment in a Catholic schools in Tasmania, teacher applicants must be or able to be registered with the <u>Teachers</u> <u>Registration Board of Tasmania</u>.
- Successful applicants for CET and school- based positions are subject to screening prior to commencement of employment. This requires the individual to undergo a police check (see form) and mandatory reporting training.
